Quality Behavioral Health has many programs to serve the community. Our Community Sexual Assault and Summer Youth Programs are grant funded and free to qualified participants. Our Mental Health and Substance Use Programs have many funding options. We accept Medicaid, Medicare, private insurances and offer private pay options as well as a sliding fee scale. Clients in crisis are eligible to receive services regardless of ability to pay. Please meet with staff to see what funding source you qualify under. The following is a sliding fee scale for those who qualify.

Note: The above is based on the 2024 federal poverty guidelines. Access to subsidized services is limited to the availability of subsidized treatment funds. **Indigent Individuals are exempt from this fee requirement.** Low income pregnant women, postpartum women up to one year post delivery and youth through 18 years of age may be exempted from co-payments if and only if the co-payments would preclude the client from continuing treatment. Exemptions must be clearly documented in the client file. **Interim Services are exempt from this fee requirement. This schedule is in effect from 01/01/2024 through 12/31/2024.** Quality Behavioral Health does not charge nominal fees for our services.
